Year 8 - 12 Students

West Sussex Fire & Rescue Service is trialling an exciting new programme for Fire Cadets and is looking for young people aged between 13 and 17 to apply.

Those successful will be joining a new Fire Cadet unit, based at Bognor Regis Fire Station, to take part in activities inspired by the role and responsibilities of a firefighter, such as completing firefighting drills and learning first aid. Each cadet will also gain essential social, life, work and wellbeing skills. The course is being trialled for one-year and this cohort of cadets will help to shape what a future programme may look like. The new Bognor Regis Fire Cadet unit will be open from 10th September and the team will meet on Tuesday evenings during school term time, 6-8pm.

To apply for the Fire Cadet programme, please <u>complete our online application form</u> by 19 July 2024. Application forms must be completed by the young person, and interviews will take place shortly after the closing date.
