

## Jewellery

No jewellery is allowed except:

- One wristwatch.
- One plain gold or silver stud in each ear lobe (with a maximum diameter of 3mm).

Any other jewellery, including rings, bracelets, necklaces and nose or eyebrow piercings, are not allowed. Transparent bars or covering with plasters is not permitted. If students attend school with jewellery other than a wristwatch or studs, they will need to remove it before they attend lessons. Jewellery may be confiscated by staff and returned at the end of the school day. Jewellery must be removed for **all** PE lessons.

We strongly advise that new piercings are done during the summer, as these must also be removed. Students who refuse or cannot remove piercings will be sent to the inclusion unit to complete appropriate written work for their safety.

## Make-up

Make-up should be discreet. False nails or coloured nail varnish should not be worn. False eyelashes should not be worn. Students may be asked to remove inappropriate make-up or nail varnish before they attend lessons.

## Hairstyles

- Hair should be kept clean and tidy and long hair should be tied back for all practical and sports activities. Hair must be tied back during all PE lessons for Health and Safety reasons.
- Very short hair, cut with graded clippers must always be grade one or above in length. Lines, patterns, symbols or words cut into hair are not acceptable.
- Extremes in colour (or unnatural colour), and extreme styles are not acceptable. Long hair with shaved undercuts are not acceptable.

## Religious observance

Head coverings need to be plain black.

# Uniform



School uniform is a key feature of a successful school.

Anyone wishing to propose a variation to the uniform policy must put their request in writing to the School Governing Body.

<b>Uniform</b>	
<b>School tie Compulsory</b>	Felpham Community College (FCC) tie.
<b>Shirt</b>	Plain white, button-through shirt with collar. Long or short-sleeved (not a blouse or polo shirt).
<b>Trousers</b>	Plain black and tailored, not tight or fitted at the ankle (not jeans or chinos).
<b>School skirt</b>	Standard FCC skirt: 22" navy tartan pattern. This is the only permissible skirt and is not to be altered. It is only available from our stockists.
<b>School blazer Compulsory</b>	FCC navy blue blazer with school badge.
<b>School jumper Optional</b>	FCC navy blue, V-neck sweatshirt with school badge.
<b>Shoes</b>	Plain 100% black (no logos or coloured markings). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Maximum 4cm heel, giving adequate support with a full back.</li> <li>• Boots are not allowed.</li> <li>• No canvas or suede shoes.</li> <li>• It must be possible to polish shoes to a shine.</li> </ul>
<b>Socks</b>	Black.
<b>Tights</b>	Black.
<b>Coat</b>	Any smart, sensible style is acceptable.
<b>Belt</b>	Black.
<b>Bag Compulsory</b>	Any durable and sturdy bag, including rucksacks, suitable for carrying school equipment and textbooks is acceptable.

<b>PE Kit - Compulsory</b>	
<b>Trainers</b>	Pair of supportive running shoes (see examples below).
<b>Shirt</b>	FCC black PE TECH polo shirt with school badge.
<b>Shorts</b>	FCC black shorts with school badge.
<b>Socks</b>	FCC purple football socks.
<b>Jumper</b>	FCC black thermal TECH jumper with school badge.

<b>Additional - if participating in these activities</b>	
<b>Boots</b>	Pair of football or rugby boots.
<b>Protective kit</b>	Shin guards and gum shield.
<b>Swimming</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• One-piece black swimming costume or black swimming trunks</li> <li>• Hairbands for long hair</li> <li>• Towel</li> </ul>

<b>PE Kit - Optional</b>	
<b>Rugby shirt</b>	FCC black reversible rugby shirt with school badge.
<b>Thermal top</b>	Black base layer thermal long sleeve top.
<b>Leggings</b>	Black base layer leggings (shorts must be worn over the top).
<b>Jacket</b>	FCC black reversible waterproof jacket with school badge.
